## **Josh Andrajack of Wichita Falls to Serve as Chair-Elect of the Independent Insurance Agents of Texas**

AUSTIN, TX — The Independent Insurance Agents of Texas (IIAT) elected Josh Andrajack of Boley-Featherston in Wichita Falls to serve as chair-elect for 2022-2023 during IIAT’s annual business meeting in San Antonio on June 24, 2022. With more than 1,500 member agencies in 225 counties, IIAT is the largest state association of independent insurance agents and professionals in the U.S.

Josh spent the first decade of his career as a commercial lender for a community bank in Wichita Falls after obtaining a finance degree from Midwestern State University. He then joined Boley-Featherston Insurance in 2008 and became a partner in 2016. In July 2021, Josh completed the buyout of the firm’s third generation of ownership to become the controlling shareholder and president. Josh’s focus areas include oil & gas and construction insurance, as well as the procurement of new market territories in Boley-Featherston’s expansion across the state.
