Josh Andrajack of Wichita Falls to Serve as Chair of the Independent Insurance Agents of Texas

AUSTIN, TX — The Independent Insurance Agents of Texas (IIAT) elected Josh Andrajack, area president of Arthur J. Gallagher Risk Management, in Wichita Falls, to serve as chair for 2023-2024 during IIAT's annual business meeting in San Antonio on June 23, 2023.
